

Getting practical training

A report by SCORE found that although there are a number of good quality practical science resources available, some practical work in schools and colleges can have a limited effect on a young persons engagement in learning.

Getting practical will support teachers, technicians and teaching assistants to improve the effectiveness of practical work through using, tailoring and managing practical science activities to meet whatever purpose the teacher has in mind.

Getting practical aims to improve the:

- clarity of learning outcomes associated with practical work
- effectiveness and impact of practical work on learning
- quality rather than quantity of practical work and to ensure that these developments are sustainable in schools



The training is split into two sessions with gap tasks to complete between sessions. The sessions are running at two venues across the county through the spring and the summer terms.
